- Bachelor's degree with a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Resume
- 3 letters of recommendation from professionals who can speak to your qualifications
- Essay based on provided prompt (650 words maximum)
- International students only
 - IELTS (minimum score of 7.0) or TOEFL scores (at least 100 on the internet version or comparable score on other versions of the exam)
 - Transcripts from non-U.S. institutions require an English translation. When needed, certified literal translation must be submitted, showing courses, grades received and degree conferral

*Prior graduate coursework can be considered for transfer credit only if it was completed within four years of the date of admission to the student's current graduate program. Also, in order for a course to be considered for transfer credit from another institution, the student must have received a grade of B or better. Only courses which were not part of an earned graduate degree may be eligible for transfer (providing the maximum number of transfer hours and the course age requirements are met). A request for transfer can be considered formally only following admission to graduate study and upon receipt of an official transcript from the institution where the work was completed.
